Wayne McNeill

1951 - 2021

Wayne was a true South Carolina native, born and raised here in Charleston but traveled wherever God led him. He graduat-

ed from William Carey College and New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. He served faithfully for 40 years in Mississippi, Georgia, North Carolina and while attending a Southern Baptist Convention he was led to missions to the northern parts of New York by the Canadian border. While in NY he also worked with Prison Fellowship and became a director over 30 prisons in the eastern side of NY, training volunteers, teaching seminars and leading weekly bible studies behind the walls. Due to aging parents and a family illness he returned south and remained here to minister in the low country serving in several churches. While serving at Jamestown Baptist Church he was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer and went to be with his Lord and Savior three months later in mid Nov 2021. He is survived by his wife and 3 children, several grandchildren and a great granddaughter.
